



YSWPCS Kindergarten Teachers

Ideas to have FUN and LEARN this summer:

- 1. Visit a new park and play WITH your child.
- 2. Play letter and math games. Use sight word cards we sent home to review.
- 3. Visit the library- OFTEN.

- 20. Play PRETEND and dress up.
- 21. Pack a pretend suitcase for visits to different places. What would you need? Visit the jungle, North Pole, New York. Find the places on a map or globe.

- 22. Sequence the events of the day at the end of the day.

- 24. Compare things- TV shows, movies, events, things around the house, etc.
- 25. Practice making decisions and learn to do chores to help out at home.
