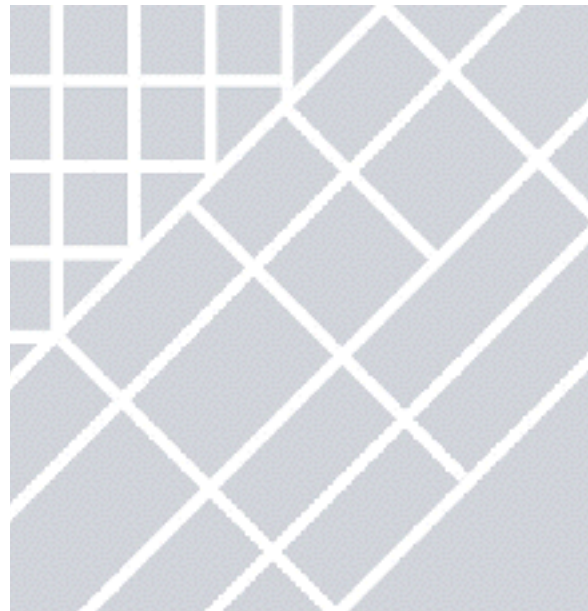
Contact Us!

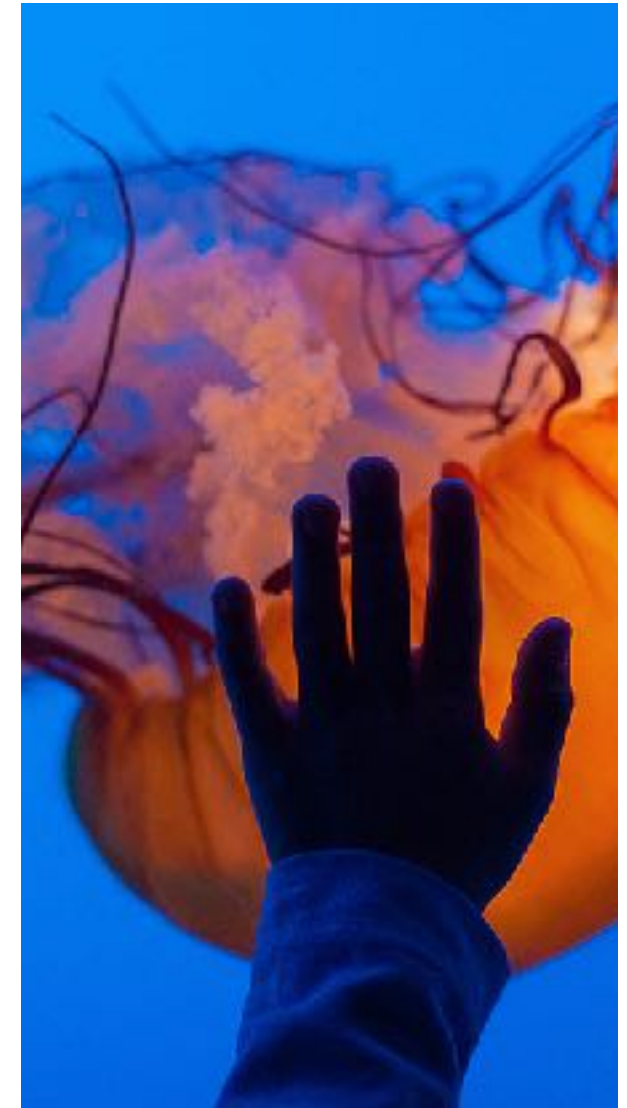
