All of the students will be parading through the parking lot once so that parents can take pictures then will be coming through again for their Trunk or Treat goodies!

Due to the construction and parking constrictions, we are limiting the amount of Trunk or Treat cars to 20. We will contact you if you are in the first 20 to RSVP. Any cars that are



not on the list will be turned away, however, if you have treats, we will make sure that they are passed out. If you are participating in Trunk or Treat by handing out treats to our students, please arrive to the school parking lot between 9 - 9:15 AM. If you are not able to come but would like to send in treats to be handed out to the students, please send in those treats before Friday 10/27/17.

We appreciate your generosity, but we ask that if you are sending in treats, that you send enough for **ALL** students. We currently have about **350** students. Though this is traditionally a time to hand out candy, we ask that you look into handing out non-food treats like stickers, glow sticks, erasers / pencils, or other fun items. We have many students with food allergies or restrictions and want to make this event as all inclusive as possible!
